3.6 Satpol PP and WH Conduct Joint Raid on Enforcement of Islamic Sharia Qanun

Following up on information submitted by the public either directly or through the media, the Civil Service Police Unit and Wilayatul Hisbah in collaboration with the ranks of the TNI, Polri, Dinas Industry, the Head of Blangkejeren Sub-district and the Head of the City of Blangkejeren carried out a joint raid activity to comb through several points that had been targeted for operations.

The activity which was carried out since 23.45 WIB was directly under the command of the Head of the WH by deploying 14 Satpol PP and WH personnel, 1 Military Police from the TNI, 2 members of the Blangkejeren Police, Head of the Department of Industry, Head of Blangkejeren Sub-district and Blangkejeren City Head. The team that moved directly to the Pujasera area carried out tight security so that there was no chance for violators to escape or hide evidence later.

From tonight's movement the team managed to secure 4 people, 2 women and 2 men they were all secured at the Gayo Lues Police Headquarters in order to undergo further examination.

Head of Regional Policy Enforcement and Islamic Sharia Saniman, SSTP., M.Si when confirmed explained to the author that the activities carried out tonight were routine activities carried out by Satpol PP and WH along with teams from other vertical agencies and related SKPK Agencies. Saniman really appreciates the information conveyed by the public regarding the existence of residents who violate the qanun in the Gayo Lues area, but in the future this information should be conveyed directly to the Satpol PP and WH, not through the media so that this future movement is truly more effective and has maximum success. Again, if informed through the media whether it's FB, Twitter, IG and others, the violators will look for a new strategy so that it is difficult to execute.

Gayo Regent Lues H. Muhammad Amru, who was carrying out official activities in Banda Aceh when contacted via WhatsApp, appreciated the movement carried out by the Satpol PP and WH and their joint raid team involving the TNI, Polri, and SKPK in this regard. The Satpol PP and WH in addition to conducting joint raids, of course, must be more active in carrying out supervision to minimize the occurrence of violations of the qanun itself because this is the main task and function attached to the fields within the Satpol PP and WH itself. Of course, in the future, Satpol PP and WH are required to innovate in regulating and organizing the qanun supervision system and mechanism in the field so that it is more effective and efficient and with maximum results, he said.

To the Gayo Lues community in general, H. Muhammad Amru hopes to cooperate well to fight the immorality of the land of a thousand hafidz that we echo, the information provided is a form of our concern for this area in order to avoid the punishment of Allah SWT, of course the information that given it, we must be able to account for the truth so that the team that will carry out the execution is not in vain.

Kasatpol PP and WH Sabri, S.Pd said that Satpol PP and WH will continue to do their best in realizing peace, order and enforcement of qanuns as well as continuous community protection. Of course, this will be difficult to achieve without the support of the community, for that Sabri hopes that the cooperation between the Satpol PP and the WH and the community must be further enhanced in supervising the implementation of the qanun in the community. IV. Conclusion

Basically Pol PP must prioritize being humane, sympathetic, carried out in accordance with the Ministry of Home Affairs No. 54 of 11 concerning Standard Operational Procedures for Satpol PP, when carrying out control, in preventing and eradicating community disease, a humane and sympathetic attitude is very important.

In carrying out the task of controlling, it is necessary to take a preventive approach, which must be the first thing that must be done by the Satpol PP when they want to curb violations of a regional regulation. For example, when they want to control street vendors on the shoulders of the road or sidewalk. "Give the traders an understanding of the Perda first, have a dialogue, don't be repressive, it's counterproductive. Therefore, the Minister of Home Affairs also asked the Governors and DPRD Leaders to always involve the Head of Satpol PP in every discussion of regional regulations. So that Satpol PP can understand the contents of the Perda that will be enforced in the field later.

In the midst of the swift currents of globalization, the role of the mass media becomes very important and strategic in the midst of people's lives, not least in the regions.

Therefore, as guardians of public peace and order as well as maintaining the enforcement of regional regulations, Satpol PP needs to establish strategic partnerships with the mass media. So that the image of Satpol PP which still tends to be seen as arrogant and repressive when dealing with the public can be changed and improved.

"We must eliminate such stigma or bad labels, of course, through the role of the mass media as a bridge of information to the wider community, by providing true information about the existence and main tasks and functions of the Satpol PP".

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
